### West Metro Fire Rescue Facts

**History:** The Lakewood Fire Protection District was founded in 1937 as the Lakewood-Mountair Fire Department.

The first fire equipment was purchased entirely with donations from the community.

In December of 1991, the Lakewood and Bancroft boards of directors began talking about consolidation. The chiefs of both districts believed the community would be better served as one agency.

The West Metro Fire Protection District was created in 1995 after the people we serve voted to consolidate the Lakewood Fire Protection District and the Bancroft Fire Protection District.

At the time, Bancroft had seven fire stations and 67 firefighters. Lakewood had six stations, with 105 firefighters. The districts finally merged on January 1, 1995, and became West Metro Fire Rescue.

**Accreditation:** West Metro Fire Rescue is one of just 308 accredited fire and emergency services agencies in the world. The qualifications set by the Commission on Fire Accreditation International (CFAI) require us to take a close look at our performance record and service levels, with an eye toward improvement, comparing our resources and response to the fire industry's best practices. Through the process, we're able to keep on top of new operating and training techniques and standards to keep you and your family safe.

West Metro is also ISO Class 1 certified- one of just 116 agencies to achieve both accreditation and the top ISO rating.

**Scholarship:** WMFR has established the Chief George Goldbach Memorial Scholarship within the Red Rocks Community College Foundation. The fund will provide scholarships for first year students attending the Fire Academy and second year Fire Science degree seeking students at the college.
